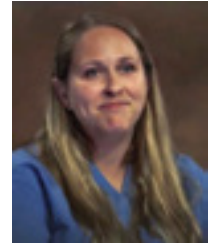

Annual Gala Raises \$2 million for Medical Intensive Care at John Muir Health

Antonio and his mother were both near death from the COVID-19 virus and in beds just doors away from each other in the Medical Intensive Care Unit at John Muir Health.

This area within our Medical Centers provides interdisciplinary care for patients with a variety of serious medical conditions in a technologically advanced environment. And unlike most community hospitals, a critical care specialist is available around the clock, seven days per week.

No one wants to spend time in a Medical Intensive Care Unit. Indeed, it would indicate a critical and life-threatening situation. But oddly enough, the public doesn't often hear much about Medical Intensive Care. According to Elvio Ardules, M.D., Pulmonary/Critical Care, John Muir Health, this may be true because "...when you have a very highly functioning Intensive Care Unit, very

complex and challenging problems get solved. Our expertise is to do those things, and to do them on a routine basis. You don't hear about it much because everything's working."

John Muir Health's annual flagship fundraiser, *Celebrate John Muir Health!* gala, was held virtually on November 6th, 2021. The event raised more than \$2 million in support of John Muir Health's Medical Intensive Care Unit and was dedicated to the heroic efforts of its team members who care for the sickest patients in our community, like Antonio and his mother.

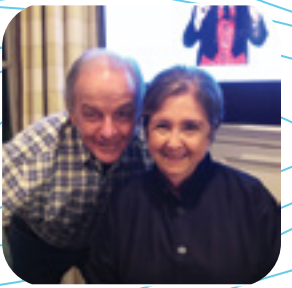
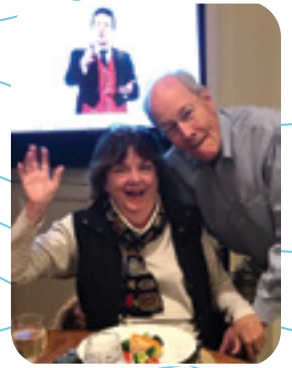

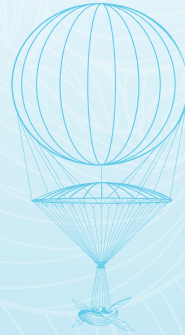

WHY I GIVE

A cup of coffee commits one to forty years of friendship.

—Turkish proverb

Their friendship began over a cup of coffee, much like so many people who connect in conversation while sharing early morning brew. But this was different because Shirley Nelson was in the midst of a ten-day stay in John Muir Health's Medical Intensive Care Unit due to pulmonary embolisms.

Her dedicated night nurse, Marc Ginn, took note of Shirley's request for a really strong cup of joe and made a special trip downstairs to Mocha Mocha Espresso Bar to purchase and hand-deliver the beverage. He couldn't help but notice a hint of Shirley's Tennessee accent, and being a southerner himself, they started talking and the seeds of a deep friendship took root.

Shirley spent another week in a Step Down Unit at John Muir Health and felt constantly impressed with the quality of care from the staff. Dr. Karen Chang assisted as her pulmonary physician and Dr. Patrick Gonzales performed her saddle embolism procedure by delivering medication through a catheter into her heart.

"Believe it or not, I was awake for the entire procedure," Shirley explains. "Dr. Gonzales was able to do this at a time when I could barely breathe and he also kept me calm by talking and reassuring me that I was in good hands ...the very BEST hands...his!"

She remembers with great joy when the clots began to dissolve and she could breathe more easily... describing the entire nursing staff as "exceptional," but especially her interactions with Marc Ginn. "His care for me was phenomenal because he made me feel like much more than just another patient on his shift."

Shirley says of Ginn, "We developed a true friendship and that has made such a difference in my experience. I mattered to him as a person, and that's just so rare."

After being moved out of the Medical Intensive Care Unit, Shirley didn't know if Marc was on duty but sent him a text message after having been spoiled with fresh coffee delivered each morning: "God will love you if you bring coffee to a certain lady." And within 15 minutes, there was Marc with Shirley's coffee.

"I could not be more impressed with the medical care I received at John Muir Health, but the people are really what make the difference."

My oxygen was at 61% when the ambulance came to my home. You know, I was really scared...but all of the folks at John Muir Health just took such good care of me—as if I was the most important person.
